Head towards the magnificent orthodox church of Holy Transfiguration of God, walking step by step through Ducic's city, and then pass through the City park where the poet enjoyed his peace and wrote poetry.

Should you continue walking onwards to Jovan Ducic Square, you will behold the catholic cathedral of The Blessed Virgin Mary, located near hundred years old plane trees.

The plane trees are simply irresistible and invite everyone for a break and refreshment in their shade.

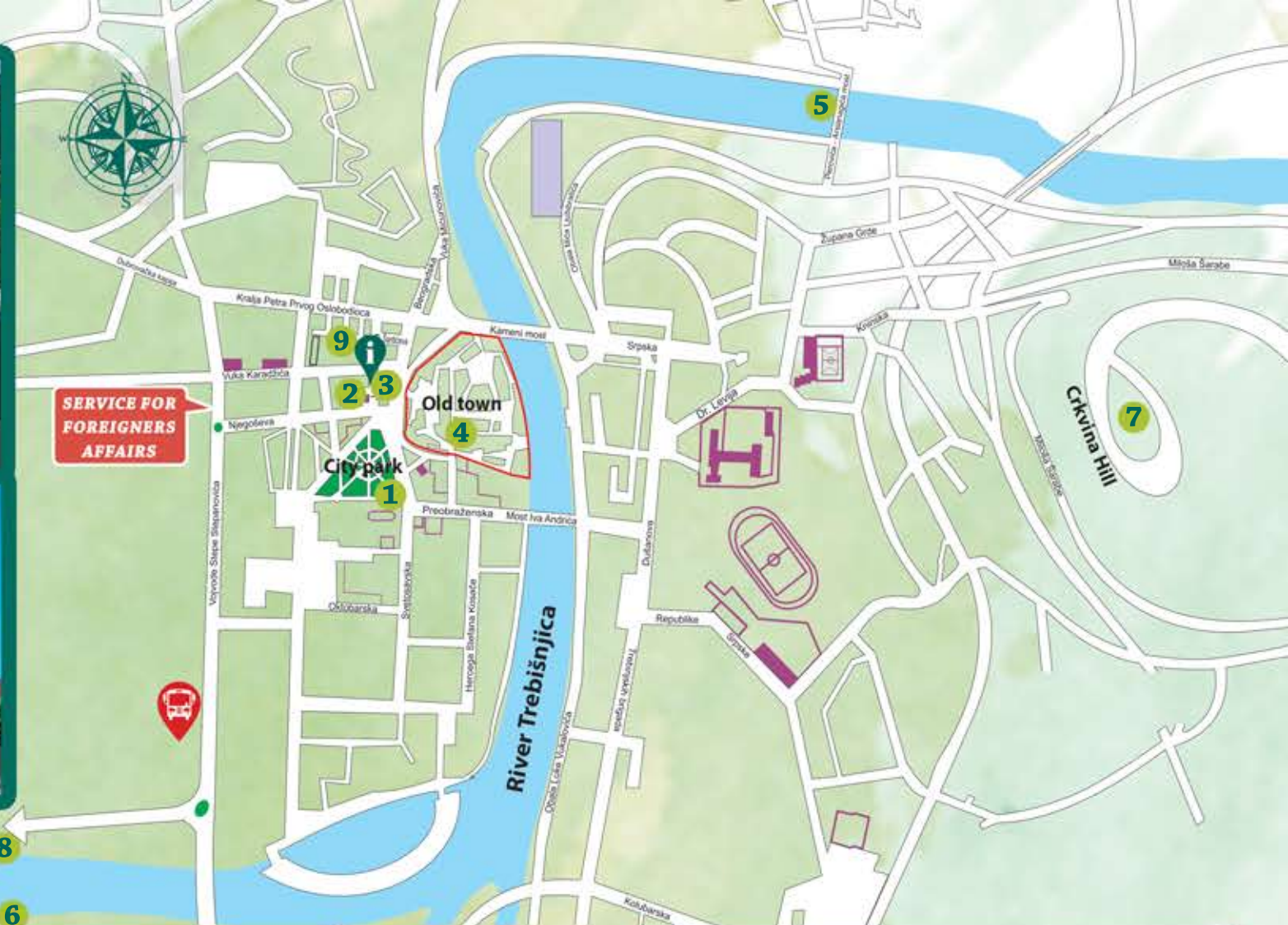
Have you heard about the saying "The visit to Trebinje doesn't count if you haven't had a coffee under the plane trees"?

The center of the city is a small green oasis with buildings from various epochs, where Mediterranean, Turkish and Austro-Hungarian styles are intertwined.

The center of the city is most recognizable for the old town "Kastel", bordered by walls from the Ottoman period. In its center there are two mosques – Sultan Ahmed mosque and Osman-pasha mosque, as well as the Museum of Herzegovina which can help you experience the ancient and rich history of Trebinje, and you will also see a selection of Ducic's gifts to Trebinje.

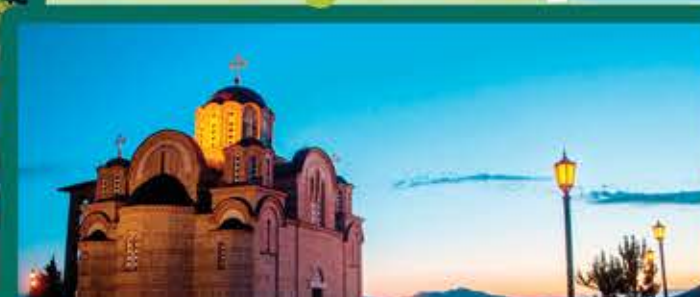

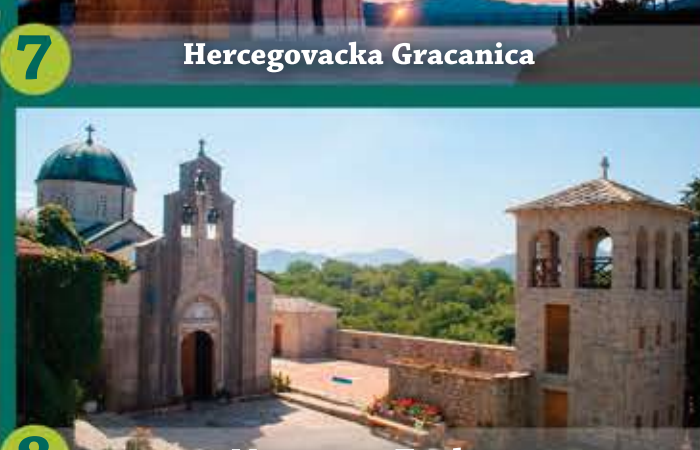

With its shades of blue color, Trebisnjica river peacefully flows through the heart of the city. Its banks are connected by several bridges, and one of them (Perovic/Arslanagic bridge) is a true gem of the Ottoman architecture and is considered to be one of the most beautiful bridges in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

For the ones who possess the spirit of adventure, there are activities such as canoeing, diving or fishing, and for the ones who seek more peaceful leisure we recommend taking relaxing walks along the river banks. During the summer, you can find refreshment on many picnic sites on Trebisnjica river and its tributary Susica, as well as in

the aqua park "City of Sun", which offers a vast selection of activities that guarantee a lot of fun for all visitors.

If you seek for the best possible view of the city, you should climb Crkvina hill, where lies the gem of Herzegovina – monastery Hercegovacka Gračanica, the resting place of our Trebinje-born poet Jovan Ducic. This location offers a magnificent view of the city, where you will find peace enjoying in colorful sunsets.

The oasis of peace and tranquility can also be found along Trebisnjica river, where you can find Tvrđos monastery lying on the river's right bank. Its walls are decorated with frescoes in such a harmony that it will surely grasp every visitor's attention.

Numerous restaurants offer a wide selection of Herzegovinian food, such as fritters (priganice) with oil cheese, cheese pie (prijesnac), roasted meat under the bell, dried lamb ribs (kastradina), brown trout, but you can also find international cuisine in Herzegovinian restaurants. Don't forget that people from Herze

govina are known for their hospitality, so the portions in restaurants are quite big.

Be sure to visit the main city market and witness the rhapsody of colors, scents and aromas. Market vendors are cheerfully offering authentic Herzegovinian products, so you will have the opportunity to taste some of them, such as figs, pomegranate juice, cornelian cherry juice, various types of tea, honey...

Our vendors can also briefly inform you how those products are made, so every visitor can know the secret of true Herzegovinian products.

After a short break, we suggest visiting one of our many wineries, where every host has an interesting story to share while you are enjoying good wine, cheese and prosciutto. Our indigenous sorts are Vranac and Zilavka, and you can also taste various other sorts of wine, brandy and liqueur. Trebinje is lively throughout the entire year. But if we were to single out the most beautiful period, it would be from spring to summer, when the city lives its life to the fullest and gives out an impression of a truly special and magical place.

Should you opt for spending a night in Trebinje, you can find all sorts of accommodation – from luxurious hotels, motels, and hostels to private apartments. Pick Trebinje, the place for all generations!
